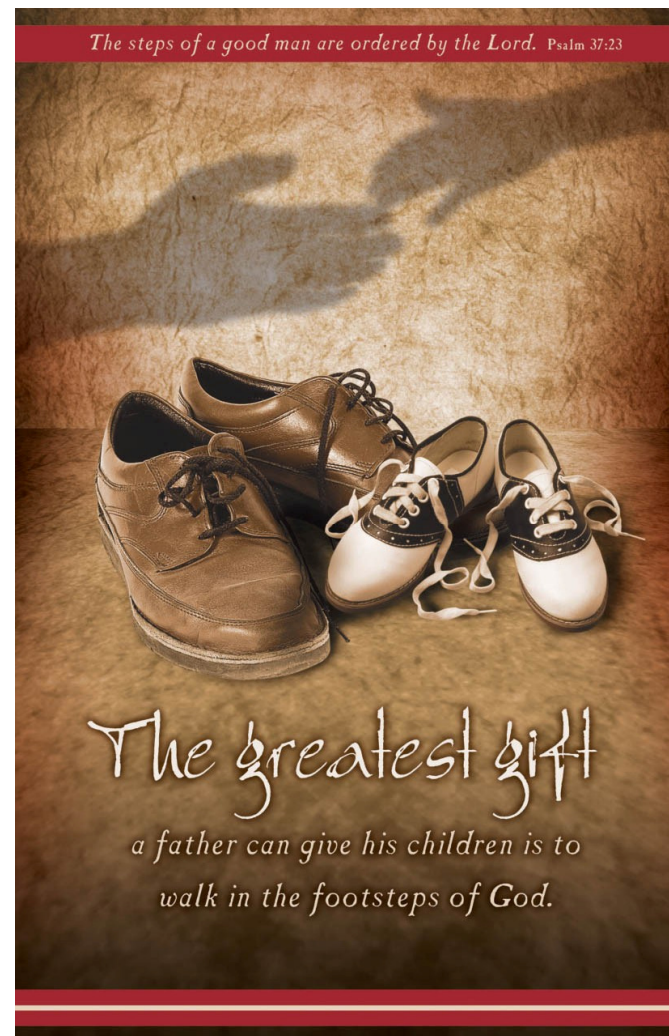
For those with health and other concerns
