**Praise God for the safe arrival of Sam Williams from Togo! Below is an excerpt from Sam's email to Steve Mills, the ABWE Togo field director and the one who took Sam to the airport Tuesday evening.**

*"Without Pastor Togbe, and God using him, we would have not gotten thru safely-- or at all. The chance of harm to our bodies, our stuff and your car was more than we could have expected.....I will never forget the last big burst where we drove through the middle of an angry, nervous mob directly behind the armored truck of the gendarmerie with police hanging out the back brandishing their tear gas guns, and Pastor gesturing strongly and shouting words of calm as you drove us through. ....It clearly did not help that at least two men had been killed by the authorities earlier that day at the onset of demonstrations over the hike in the gas prices and the cutting of government price supports...."* **This gives more meaning to praying for the safety of our missionaries!! Glory be to God!**
